

**REGISTRATION POLICY FOR SMOKE PERSIAN CATS**  
**Approved at GCCF Council meeting 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2012.**

**FULL REGISTER (CS)**

Smoke Persians with Championship or Provisional status which have in their pedigrees within three generations Persians in colours shown in the chart as being acceptable for this register. Both parents to be either Full Register or at least third generation Supplementary Register.

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGISTER (CSSR)**

Smoke Persians with Championship or Provisional status which have in their pedigrees within three generations Persians in colours shown in the chart as being acceptable for this register.

**REFERENCE REGISTER (CSREF)**

Smoke Persians which have in their pedigrees within three generations Persians in any non-accepted colour or pattern or cats from any other breed section.

Smoke Persians which have in their pedigrees any unregistered parent, grandparent or great-grandparent.

**A. ACTIVE REGISTER**

All Smoke Persians registered with the GCCF from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2013 may be registered on the Active Register, at the breeder's request, only if one of the following applies

1. They themselves have been genetically tested as normal (clear) for PKD (Polycystic Kidney Disease).\*
2. Both parents have been tested normal (clear) as in A.1
3. They are from parents deemed normal (clear) because of the results from testing (as in A.1) of cats on every pedigree line in previous generations. Pedigree line in this case refers to both parents, or 4 grandparents, 8 great-grandparents, 16 great-great-grandparents and so on, or any combination of the same which is inclusive of both the sire's and dam's ancestors.

**B. GENETIC REGISTER**

1. All Smoke Persians which have been genetically tested as positive for PKD, shall be registered on the Genetic Register, or on the Non-Active register if so requested by the breeder.
2. All Smoke Persians which are not eligible for registration on the Active Register, shall be registered on the Genetic Register, or on the Non-Active register if so requested by the breeder.
3. Offspring of cats registered on the Genetic Register may only be registered on the Active Register if they have themselves been genetically tested as normal (clear) for PKD.

4. All other offspring of cats registered on the Genetic Register shall be registered on the Genetic Register, or on the Non-Active Register if so requested by the breeder.

\* Cats must be microchipped for identification purposes, and the chip number shown on the laboratory test results, and included in the cat's veterinary record.

**REGISTRATION POLICY FOR CAMEO & PEWTER PERSIAN CATS**

**Approved at Council meeting 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2012.**

**FULL REGISTER (CS)**

Cameo and Pewter Persians with Championship or Provisional status which have in their pedigrees within three generations Persians in colours shown in the chart as being acceptable for this register. Both parents to be either Full Register or at least third generation Supplementary Register.

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGISTER (CSSR)**

Cameo & Pewter Persians with Championship or Provisional status which have in their pedigrees within three generations Persians in colours shown in the chart as being acceptable for this register.

**REFERENCE REGISTER (CSREF)**

Cameo & Pewter Persians which have in their pedigrees within three generations Persians in any non-accepted colour or pattern or cats from any other breed section.

Cameo & Pewter Persians which have in their pedigrees any unregistered parent, grandparent or great-grandparent.

**A. ACTIVE REGISTER**

All Cameo or Pewter Persian registered with the GCCF from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2013 may be registered on the Active Register at the breeder's request, only if one of the following applies

1. They themselves have been genetically tested as normal (clear) for PKD (Polycystic Kidney Disease).\*
2. Both parents have been tested normal (clear) as in A.1
3. They are from parents deemed normal (clear) because of the results from testing (as in A.1) of cats on every pedigree line in previous generations. Pedigree line in this case refers to both parents, or 4 grandparents, 8 great-grandparents, 16 great-great-grandparents and so on, or any combination of the same which is inclusive of both the sire's and dam's ancestors.

**B. GENETIC REGISTER**

1. All Cameo & Pewter Persians which have been genetically tested as positive for PKD, shall be registered on the Genetic Register, or on the Non-Active register if so requested by the breeder.
2. All Cameo & Pewter Persians which are not eligible for registration on the Active Register, shall be registered on the Genetic Register, or on the Non-Active register if so requested by the breeder.
3. Offspring of cats registered on the Genetic Register may only be registered on the Active Register if they have themselves been genetically tested as normal (clear) for PKD.
4. All other offspring of cats registered on the Genetic Register shall be registered on the Genetic Register, or on the Non-Active Register if so requested by the breeder.

\* Cats must be microchipped for identification purposes, and the chip number shown on the laboratory test results, and included in the cat's veterinary record.
